Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The standing Grace OPC church sign – fifty feet from the front doors to the church building – has such sustained cumulative and *visible* weather damage.

At the end of 2021 into 2022, the Session and Trustees commissioned Georgi Kanev draft a design would God-glorifying and Gospel-inviting and weather-enduring. However, the purchase of the new sign was put on hold due to the economics of our church at that time.

Now, it is the judgment of the Session, in communication with the Trustees, that the current sign should be replaced with a new sign that will, in a God-honoring and Spirit-sanctified way, aesthetically draw our neighbors' attention to the place in Fair Lawn and Saddle Brook where Good News can be heard.

Georgi Kanev reached out to the Customer Rep from Great American Sign Co. and he has graciously agreed to the 2022 price quote of \$4,105 for the purchase and installation of the new sign.

In light of the need and the cost, the Session encourages our members and friends to prayerfully consider contributing to this special offering for a New Grace OPC Church sign.

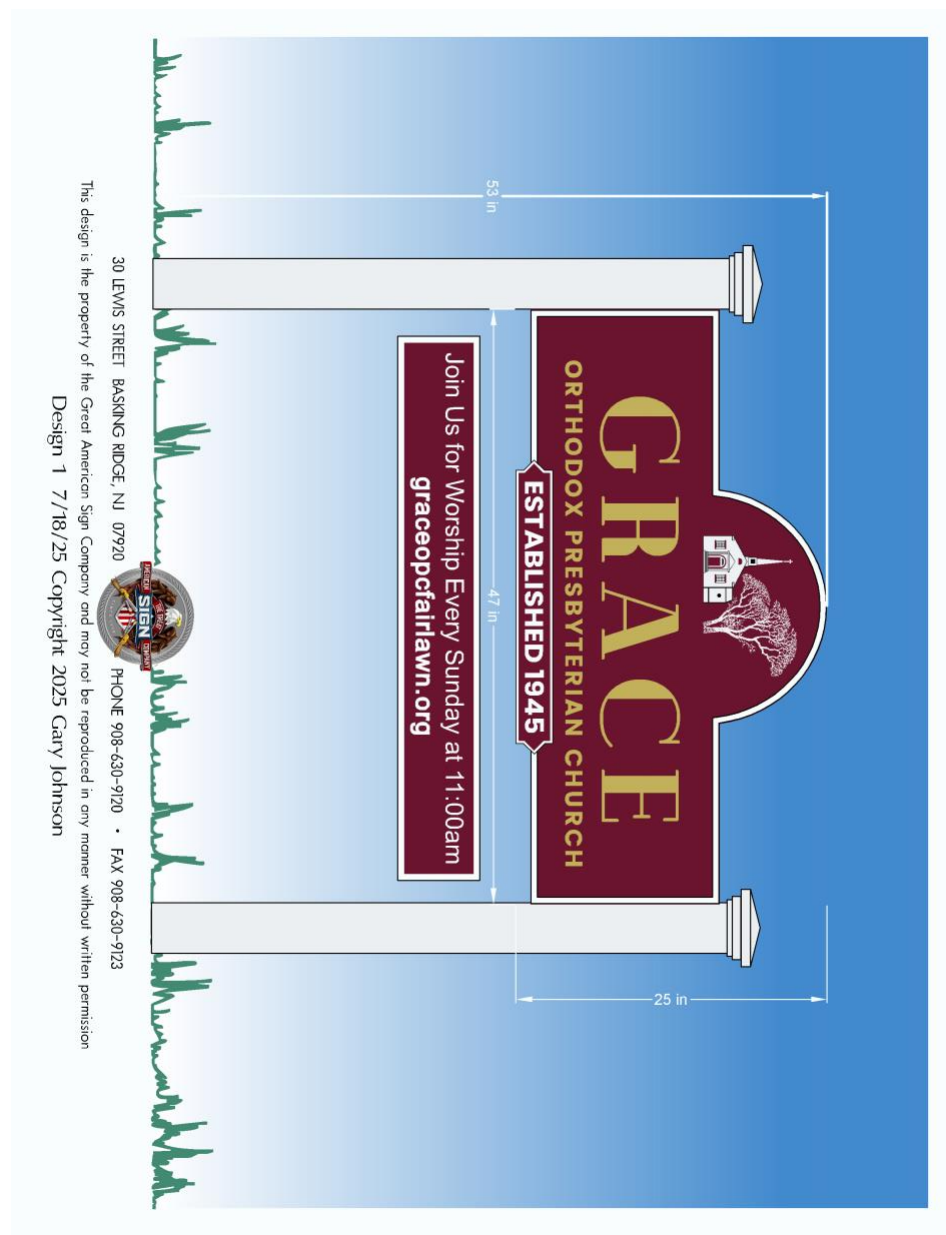

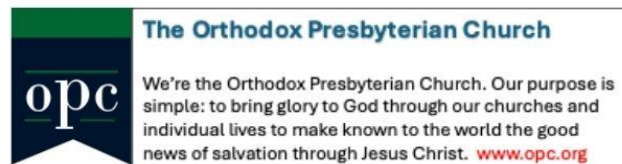
