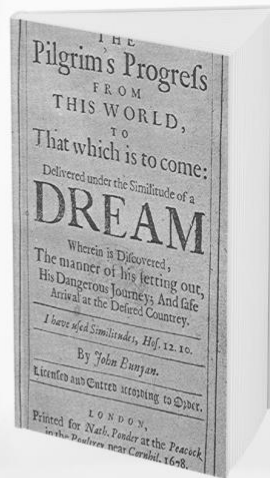
CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP: BOOK READING & DISCUSSION
